SPANISH

COURSE CONTENT

The course will enable students to develop their linguistic skills alongside their understanding of the culture and society of the countries where Spanish is spoken.

Students will study technological and social change. They will study highlights of Hispanic artistic culture, including a focus on Spanish regional identity and the cultural heritage of past civilisations.

They will learn about aspects of the diverse political landscape of the Hispanic world. Students will explore the influence of the past on present-day Spanish-speaking communities.

Throughout their studies, they will learn the language in the context of Spanish-speaking countries and the issues and influences which have shaped them.

Students will study texts and film and will have the opportunity to carry out independent research on an area of their choice.

PREPARATION FOR STUDYING THIS SUBJECT

- Listen to Spanish radio as often as possible
- Watch 'Euronews' in Spanish
- Revise all tenses covered at GCSE before starting the A Level course

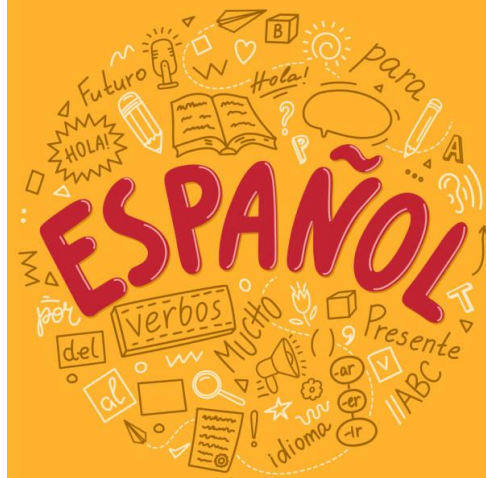
ENTRY REQUIREMENTS
